First, all new students' parents in grades K-8 must be registered in Power School. If you haven't already done so, please contact Mrs. Gumbert in the school office.

Second, we are in need of lunch recess volunteers to help the teachers monitor the children outside and inside on inclement days. Lunches run from 10:45AM to 12:10PM. If you are available please call the office for more information.

No one is permitted to enter the classrooms after school hours, especially during a function hosted by an organization of St. Bartholomew. Along with Father Tom our pastor, I hope this will not be an issue any longer.
